The project will be run jointly by the CAU and ACA and the test pit excavations will look at how the archaeology continues outside the Northstowe excavations. Test pits are just 1m², create a minimum of disturbance and can be sited anywhere you wish (on unscheduled land). The digging can be done by you, your family and friends, or by interested members of the public from elsewhere.
